

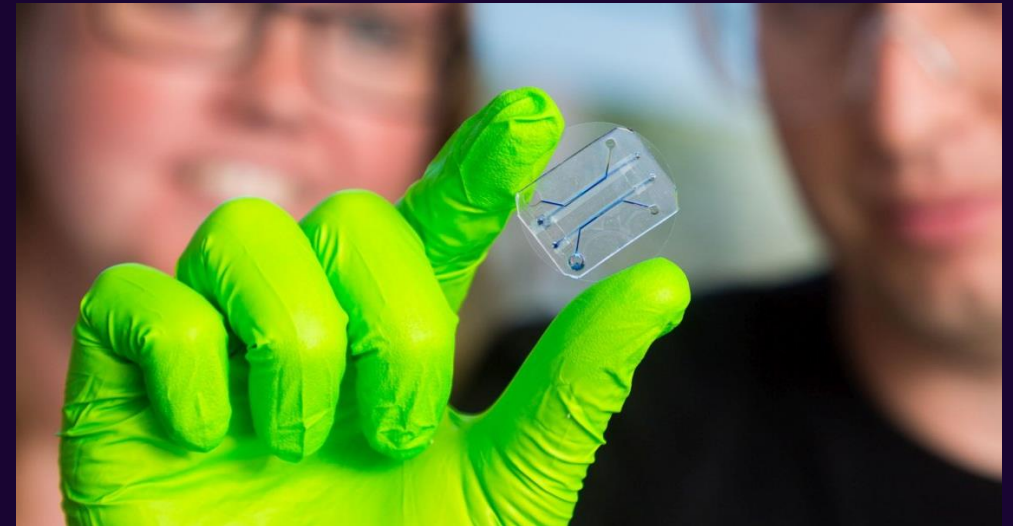


No Grants, no glory!

- **Chiron** develops organs-on-a-chip models that can be utilized in the development of new pharmaceuticals and fundamental research.
- **Project overview:** The current state of the art allows for the utilization of six chambers within a single microplate. However, there is a growing demand for high-throughput methods in fundamental research, drug development, and healthcare. To meet this need, Chiron together with, the University of Twente, TNO, Medace, Hy2Care, and the University of Maastricht, have set out to develop a novel high-throughput 3D cartilage-on-a-chip model.
- **We provided:** Strategy alignment, grant application preparation, submission, rebuttals, and assistance with the financial technical test.

- **Rollz International** develops innovative, modern rollators equipped with cutting-edge technology to support the elderly in their daily lives.
- **Project Overview:** To assist blind elderly individuals, Rollz International initiated a feasibility study to explore the development of a novel rollator capable of providing sensory input to visually impaired users, helping them navigate their surroundings safely and avoid falls or collisions within their living environment.
- **We provided:** Grant application preparation, Budget alignment, submission, rebuttals, and assistance with the financial technical test.

- **Orthros Medical** Dutch biotech company developing VHH based therapeutics and diagnostics for animal and human health.
- **Project overview:** Osteoarthritis (OA) is a degenerative joint disease affecting both humans and animals, causing pain and reduced quality of life. Current treatments rely on NSAIDs, which have significant side effects. This project focuses on developing a locally injected VHH treatment for dogs, with potential future application in human healthcare.
